What are we learning:

In English, we will developing our writing skills through a balanced argument. We will be looking at national parks and whether you should be allowed to feed the animals in these parks. Then we will be writing a book review based on a book we will be reading in class.

This term will be looking at using possessive apostrophes correctly and experimenting with complex, compound, and simple sentences.

In maths, we will be continuing with our multiplication skills. We will be learning how to multiply 2 and 3 digit numbers by a 1 digit number using short multiplication. Then we will be learning how to divide larger numbers using a range of strategies.


After that, we will move onto investigating perimeter of various 2D shapes.
