What are We learning:

Our topic this term is: How did the Romans come to invade Britain?

In English, we will be continuing with our adventure story inspired by 'The Secret of Black Rock'. Then, we will move onto a narrative about a natural disaster, based on the events at Pompeii. Finally, writing a newspaper report on how the Romans invaded Britain. We will continue with a focus on good handwriting and sentence structure, whilst also looking at subordinating clauses and speech.

In maths, our focus Will be on Fractions followed by Mass and Capacity. We Will also be continuing With our Weekly timestable quiz.

Our science topic will look at Forces and we will learn about push and pull forces. We will also be comparing how things move on different surfaces as well as understanding how magnets work and how they attract or repel each other as well as other materials.

In DT, we will be designing and making our own shell structures that will hold an egg.

In History, we will be looking at how the Romans built the Roman Empire, invaded other countries as well as the impact they had on Britain.
