Welcome back. We hope you have had a relaxing half term break.

## What we are learning

This half term our Geography topic is 'What is it like to live in India?' We will be looking at the similarities and differences between Church Fenton and Chembakolli in India. This will inspire some of our writing as we will be rewriting a traditional Indian story.

We will be using our Science topic about animals to inspire our report writing and will choose an animal to research and write a report about.

We are very excited to be putting on an Easter performance for you just before the Easter break. We will be spending our time rehearsing our lines and perfecting our acting skills!

## Super Science

Our topic is 'How do animals and humans grow and change' and we will be learning about lifecycles and how different creatures mature into adulthood.

## Spelling and Reading

We are focussing on fluency and comprehension during our reading sessions. Please encourage your child to ask an adult if they find a word they are unfamiliar with.

We practise our reading daily. Your child's book will be changed once each week on a Monday. Our library books will be changed on a Friday.

Each week we will learn a spelling rule and a list of words in class. The children will be set an assignment on Spelling Shed for the following week to practise those spellings. Playing these fun games 3 or 4 times a week for between 5 and 10 minutes is ideal and will support their learning in class. The assignments will be set each Friday.

## Maths



We will continue our multiplication and division learning, becoming fluent in multiplying and dividing by 2, 5 and 10 and using these facts to solve problems.

We will then learn to measure in cm and m and to compare and order lengths and heights before using this knowledge to solve problems. Our final topic this term is mass, temperature and capacity. We will learn to measure these accurately using the relevant units of measurement and use the four operations to solve problems.

Our KIRF for this half term is to know the multiplication and division facts for the 10 times table. An information sheet with ideas for practising this at home can be found on the website.
