Welcome back to school.

We hope that everybody had a wonderful and a relaxing Easter break! We have a great half term of learning ahead of us and hopefully the sun will keep shining down on us.

What are We learning:

Our topic this term is: What Were Stone Age settlements like?

In English, we will be writing a narrative about a natural disaster, based on the events at Pompeii. After that, we will be moving onto a narrative based on a child finding themselves in the Neolithic Stone Age. We will continue with a focus on good handwriting and sentence structure, whilst also looking at prepostions, conjunctions and apostrophes for possession.

In maths, our focus will be completing the last few sessions on Mass and Capacity followed by Fractions and then Money. We will also be continuing with our weekly timestable quiz.

Our science topic will be looking at plants. The children will identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants. Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth and investigate how water is transported within plants.

In History, we will be exploring the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age and investigating how the lives of people in Britain changed through looking at the areas of housing, weaponry and farming.
