What we are learning

This half term our topic is 'Me and My World'. In Geography, we will be finding out about 'Our Local Area' and making maps of the school and Church Fenton. We will be learning about 'Our Body and Senses' in Science and we will be thinking about 'Who is a Christian and what do they believe?' in RE. In English, we are excited to be continuing with Drawing Club and we will be looking at a different book each week to support our writing.



Reading

Reading books will be sent home on Monday and will be changed each Monday.

Spellings

In Year I, spellings are part of the weekly homework. The children will access Spelling Shed to support their learning. Logins and further information will be sent out over the next few weeks.

Phonics

We will continue to follow the Little Wandle phonics sche me. This half term we will be recapping phase 3 & phase 4 sounds. We will then begin to teach phase 5 sounds. We will update you regularly on our teaching of phonics and how you can support your child at home. This half term we will be recapping all of the 49 tricky words from reception. Your child needs to be secure sight reading all of these words before moving on to Year I words. Further information about how you can help with spelling tricky words will be sent out in a couple of weeks after we have completed a short assessment.

Maths



In Maths we will be counting with objects to 10, comparing numbers, finding one more and one less and practising our number bonds to 10. We will also be focussing on forming all numbers up to 10 correctly.

Accessing Numbots regularly will hugely improve your child's mental maths skills. This is part of your child's weekly homework. Logins will be sent out next week.

Our KIRFS (Key instant recall facts) for this half term are to count to 50 and to say one more and one less than a given number to 10.
