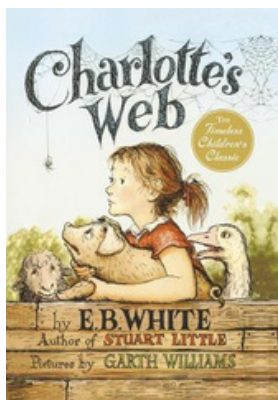


We hope you have had a lovely half term and have loved hearing what the children have been doing throughout. If you have any questions or concerns about your child, please don't hesitate to come and speak to me.
