What are we Learning?

Set during World War 1, Private Peaceful charts eight hours in the life of Tommo, a young soldier at the Front as he looks back over the formative events of his life: his father's early death, his relationship with his loving mother and brothers, Big Joe and Charlie, and their beloved school friend Molly.
