What we are learning

Our topic this half term is 'London's Calling and we will be finding out about our capital city of London. In Geography, we will be identifying the four countries and capital cities of the UK and it's surrounding seas. We will also be looking at the famous landmarks of London and learning about it's physical and human features. Our Science topic is animals, we will be identifying and naming a variety of animals as well as describing and comparing their structure. In Art, we will be exploring 'Found Art' and designing and constructing famous London Landmarks using recycled materials. In English we will be writing an adventure story based in London and writing a non-chronological report about the four countries and capital cities of the UK.
