





What we are learning


















Our Values this half term are

This half term we will be looking at numbers to 5. We will practise counting as well as subitising (saying how many there are without counting them). We will be comparing amounts, using the words 'more than,''fewer than' and 'an equal number.' We will be matching numerals to quantities within IO. We will also be practising verbally counting beyond 20.
